## Hebrews 9

9:1-5 This was very beautiful but remember it's just a shadow of the real. Not only that but it could only be seen by one person once a year. But around all this beauty is blood, sprinkled year after year. It must have made quite a contrast. The golden ark and lampstand, the cherubim and wings arched over the place where the Shekinah glory settled. We are all free to go in the reality and "worship the beauty of His holiness" because of the perfect blood shed once for all. Do you ever visualize this as you pray? Do you recognize prayer as such a sacred moment?

9:6-10 The shadow continues until the reality is come. Why didn't Jesus just come way back when this all began?

9:11-14 The old system made them outwardly clean for the sake of ritual. The new changes the heart and brings an inward cleansing so that the outside becomes clean too. Jesus preached this over and over. Can you remember instances?

9:15-22 Why blood? The life of the flesh is in the blood. To ransom us a life had to take our place, the blood poured out. All the Old Testament rituals looked forward to this blood of our ransom.

9:23-28 It's a done deal! Are you waiting, eager to greet him? What does it mean that He brings us SALVATION?
