Psalm 110

Of David. A psalm.

- ¹ The LORD says to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet."
- (JHWH says to Adonai The Eternal One says to the Master. Reminds me of Jesus parable Lk 19 ruler went to be made king -This is the most quoted verse in the NT)
- ² The LORD will extend your mighty scepter from Zion; you will rule in the midst of your enemies.
- (Jesus will one day reign from Zion, but today he reigns in my heart (midst). Zion is the city of God, and that is who we are. I was an enemy but now I am in the train of the conqueror, He conquered me with love.)
- ³ Your troops will be willing on your day of battle. Arrayed in holy majesty, from the womb of the dawn you will receive the dew of your youth.
- (I see the alternate translation more fitting. Young men will come to You like the dew. We will rise to be his warriors and will be in our prime, as we rise like the dew rose from the earth in the days before the flood, for the last battle.)
- ⁴ The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind: "You are a priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek."
- (Praise God it is an eternal oath that can never change, Jesus, my intercessor.) ⁵ The Lord is at your right hand; he will crush kings on the day of his wrath. (See vs 1. Adonai at the hand of power of JHWH. See Ps 2. He is at the right hand of JHWH and here He is at our right hand, crushing his enemies through us.)
- ⁶ He will judge the nations, heaping up the dead and crushing the rulers of the whole earth.
- (Praise God the end of man's weak and polluted governments. The KING will reign in righteousness that has never been displayed before, for He alone is the Righteous Branch. Daniel 2 rock that strikes the mountain will fill the whole earth.)
- ⁷ He will drink from a brook beside the way; therefore he will lift up his head. (Again both translations work. A reminder of Gideon. He does not need a multitude, for He is the Anointed, and only the ones chosen and ready, watching, will He take with him on this glorious march. Alternate translation goes with the other verses of Adonai being at the right hand of JHWH. 'Him that I shall choose' Deut 17:15)
